



2018/2019 STEM Scholarship Opportunity

The *Southeastern New England Defense Industry Alliance* (SENEA) is pleased to announce that we will be awarding two (2) \$1500 scholarships for the 2018/2019 academic year to students pursuing a career in STEM-related fields (such as engineering, computer science, cybersecurity, information technology, mathematics, etc.), with the potential to support the future national security and defense sector workforce.

Eligibility:

- The student must be a matriculating student enrolled in a STEM field at an accredited college or university located in the U.S.
- The student must be entering their 4th semester of study, or later equivalent, in the 2018-2019 academic year
- The student must be a U.S. citizen and a resident of Southeastern New England (Rhode Island, Connecticut, Massachusetts)

The student must fully complete and submit the required application including all required supporting documentation by the submission deadline.

Award Criteria (in priority order):

- The student must demonstrate to the review committee, through an essay, their interest in and passion for a STEM-related career.
- The student's overall G.P.A. with a concentrated focus on all STEM college level courses will be reviewed (unofficial college/university transcripts are acceptable).
- Letters of recommendation provided with the completed submission will be evaluated.
- Honors and awards will be assessed.
- The student's involvement in community service, civic and volunteer efforts, employment, and extra-curricular activities will be considered.
- Recognition will be awarded to any student related to a SENEA member or who is working for a SENEA member company.
