Expectations of Internship Host-

- Provide the intern the opportunity to learn from your team, engaging them in opportunities to sit in on meetings, work on projects or engage in trainings.
- Share your expertise and provide feedback to the intern to help them grow!

Benefits of Becoming an Internship Host-

- SENEDIA provides your organization with a qualified student in their last year of college for an 80-hour internship.
- SENEDIA has screened, interviewed interns prior to determining internship placement.
- RI state grant covers the majority of the intern's stipend. Organizations are asked to pay a \$200 co-share to cover the remainder of the stipend.
- SENEDIA will take care of stipend payments, timesheets, and regular communication with the intern with weekly check-ins.
